Registration Policies

All camper paperwork, including an up-to-date health inventory completed by a medical professional, must be submitted to the CDC office by June 1, 2021, or for late registrations, 2 full business days before your child comes to camp. Current CDC students may use health records on file for the 2021-22 school year.

Children must be 3-years old by April 1, 2021, be **dependably** potty-trained and in regular underwear. *No pull-ups.* Parent or designated adult must be available to change accidents, upon request.

Parents are expected to arrive just prior to dismissal. A late pick-up fee may be charged if the camper's adult is not present at 12:15 pm.

Campers must be picked up within 30 minutes of notification of illness or injury.

Campers and their families must follow all COVID policies. These policies may become more or less restrictive, depending on the local COVID metrics at camp time. The safety of ALL campers is our utmost concern. We appreciate everyone's cooperation.

COVID Policies

In response to the COVID pandemic, campers will be required to wear masks, to wash hands upon arrival and often during the day, and to work in small groups and outdoors whenever possible. The staff will sanitize throughout the day and keep the camp group separate from other groups on campus. The same camp staff are assigned all week.

Families will complete a health screen daily. Each camper's temperature will be checked upon arrival.

We ask families to **NOT travel the week (7 days) before coming to camp.** Since COVID symptoms typically manifest within a week of exposure, being out of your "bubble" just before camp starts can put all campers and staff at risk. Please review your summer plans before registering.

July 26-30 Dinosaur Roar!

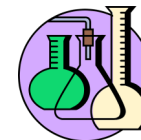
Dinosaur digs and all things pre-historic will delight the budding paleontologist. Make fossils, play in a pretend tar pit and learn about dinosaurs found in
